The Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolutions 1267 (1999) and 1989 (2011) concerning Al-Qaida and Associated Individuals and Entities presents his compliments to the Permanent Representatives and Observers to the United Nations and wishes to convey the following:

On **31 March 2015**, the individual specified below was **deleted** from the Al-Qaida Sanctions List. The entry was deleted after the Committee concluded its consideration of the de-listing request for this name submitted through the Office of the Ombudsperson established pursuant to Security Council resolution 1904 (2009), and of the Comprehensive Reports of the Ombudsperson on this de-listing request. The assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution 2161 (2014) adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations accordingly no longer apply to this entry.
